ORDINANCE NO. 36-2011

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 13-1996 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 13-1996 was enacted to allow the Board of Lake County Commissioners the authority to service a 2.755 acre parcel within the Village with sanitary sewer service; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 13-1996 was written so as, and intended solely, to give effect to Section 1 of said Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Ordinance No. 13-1996 has created apparent, albeit unfounded, confusion due to its language, and, given that Section 2 is not needed to give effect to the purposes and intents of Ordinance No. 13-1996, said Section should be repealed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 13-1996 is hereby repealed and shall be held for naught.

SECTION 2. The remainder of Ordinance No. 13-1996 not hereby repealed remains in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of this Village, and for the further reason that this Ordinance is required to be immediately effective so as to avoid any misunderstands regarding the legal rights and responsibilities pertaining to sanitary sewer service within the Village, which

misunderstandings may have immediate negative practical and legal implications; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage if passed by the affirmative vote of at least five members of Council and otherwise at the earliest time provided by Ohio law.


