RESOLUTION NO. 1-2012

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR ALYSON MORITZ AS THE DESIGNEE OF THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL FOR PURPOSES OF THE PUBLIC RECORDS LAW

WHEREAS, Ohio law requires elected officials to undergo educational training for every term of office related to the requirements of the public records law, Ohio Revised Code Section 149.43; and

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 109.43 provides that the members of a public office may appoint a Designee to undergo such training on their behalf; and

WHEREAS, the Village Administrator has charge of the day-to-day affairs of the Village pertaining to public records law compliance and, therefore, the Council has determined that Administrator Alyson Moritz should serve as the legal Designee of the members of Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF MADISON, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION 1. Administrator Alyson Moritz is hereby appointed the "Designee" within the meaning set forth in Ohio Revised Code Section 109.43 for the members of Council holding office as of the date of passage of this Resolution and she is hereby assigned all duties, responsibilities and obligations as are permitted by law to be assigned to a Designee.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest time provided by law.
